

TEACH INTERNATIONAL – OVERSEAS TESOL COURSES

Terms and Conditions*

1. Full payment for an overseas course must be received by Teach International 14 days prior to commencement of the course.
2. If full payment is not received 14 days prior, the position may be allocated to a person on the waiting list.
3. There will be no refund of the 'overseas' fee (\$500) if cancellation is outside 30 days of course commencement date. All course fees may be transferred to a future Teach International course, either in Australia, New Zealand or another overseas location if offered. Course fees expire 12 months from enrolment date.
4. If cancellation is made within 15 days of course commencement date, the 'overseas fee' (\$500) cannot be transferred to a future course either in Australia, New Zealand or another overseas location if offered. There will be no refund of the 'overseas fee' (\$500) if cancellation is made within 15 days of course commencement date.
5. Installment plans are not available on overseas courses.
6. The 'overseas' fee (\$500) to attend the course overseas is in addition to the usual cost of the course and no pro-rata amounts are available if not completing the practical teaching components.
7. There will be no refund provided for anyone who leaves the in-class course early or does not complete the practical teaching components in the overseas location. Completion of unfinished components may be undertaken in other Teach International AU or NZ locations if available.
8. If Teach International has to cancel any course components due to unforeseen circumstances, these components will be made available in other AU or NZ Teach International course locations.
9. No discount vouchers can be used towards the cost of the course.
10. The 5% upfront payment discount and \$50 friends discount is available on overseas courses, but the discount applies only to the course fee, not the additional 'overseas' fee (\$500).
11. All participants of an overseas TESOL course must take out appropriate travel insurance for the thirteen day period of the TESOL training component, and a receipt and policy details must be provided to Teach International at least one week prior to departure. If travel insurance is secured in conjunction with the Study Overseas Program early bird special, policy recipients are responsible for travel insurance outside course dates.
12. Flights, accommodation, insurance, visas, and vaccinations are the responsibility of all attendees, and Teach International takes no responsibility for cancellation of flights, non-issuance of visas or insurance, or for the provision and availability of accommodation.
13. All participants must arrive in the overseas location by the day prior to commencement of the first day of the in-class course for the orientation evening.
14. Positions are limited to 25 participants and preference will be given to participants undertaking the full in-class course components and practical teaching.
15. A hard copy of these Terms and conditions must be signed and returned as part of the overseas course registration procedure.
16. Teach International reserves the right to alter these terms and conditions without notice.

5. THE COMPANY'S LIABILITY:

(a) Teach International is a course provider and does not make provisions for travel insurance, accommodation, visas, passports, transport, vaccinations or vehicles. The services that Teach International supplies consists of arranging courses, providing training, practice teaching and small tours. All registrations made with Teach International are subject to the terms and conditions and limitations of liability imposed by such third parties, some of which limit or exclude liability in respect to death, personal injury, delay and loss or damage of baggage.

(b) The Student hereby agrees that no liability will attach to Teach International or to any other members of the courses in respect of death, personal injury or illness of the Student and/or the loss or damage to the property and effects of the Student during the length of the course howsoever caused. The Student taking the course overseas must have full understanding that he/she travels entirely at his/her own risk. For the purposes of this clause Teach International shall be deemed to contract and its independent contractors as well as on its own behalf. This clause shall not apply so as to exempt Teach International from any liability in respect of which Teach International is obliged to by law.

(c) If the fulfillment of the course is rendered impossible, or in Teach International's opinion inadvisable, by strike, war, epidemic, governmental interference or any other cause beyond Teach International's control, Teach International reserves the right at any time to cancel the course or change other details thereof that it thinks fit.

The Student shall be bound by any cancellation or alteration made under the provisions of this clause and the above terms and conditions. This shall be the full extent of Teach International's liability and the Student should effect suitable personal travel insurance to cover additional risks.

6. STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY: Any Student suffering from any form of physical or mental incapacity that might impede their travel or ability to complete the course must bring this to the notice of Teach International when registering. All Students must also comply with all legislation, visas, immigration, customs, foreign exchange and health regulations of the countries visited.

It is the Student's responsibility to familiarise themselves with any/all health, entry/exit visa and other documentation requirements that may be applicable to the areas that are to be visited. Passport, travel insurance, visa, accommodation and vaccination requirements are not the responsibility of Teach International and Teach International will not be liable for any loss or expense due to the Student's (or their Travel Agents) failure to comply with the above.
