Introduction

Teach International is holding a TESOL course in London in May 2009. This course provides students who want to work in Europe the opportunity to meet the demand for English teachers that eventuates during the European summer months (June, July and August). During this period, English language schools hold summer courses and student numbers increase dramatically. Schools require qualified TESOL teachers to meet this demand.

Training

On successful completion of the Certificate III in TESOL or Certificate IV in TESOL course, you will be eligible to apply for a range of jobs currently available through our contacts at European English language schools. To complete the Certificate III in TESOL or the Certificate IV in TESOL, you will need to have completed the online material by 25 May. The in-class component and practice teaching will then be completed on-site in London.

Job Guarantee

Teach International provides a money-back job guarantee available to Certificate IV in TESOL students who meet the eligibility criteria. Please read the London Course Terms and Conditions for more information about the job guarantee and eligibility criteria.

Employment

Opportunities for employment are based on the outcome of an interview Teach International will organise for you with employers seeking teachers to work in the United Kingdom, Italy, France, Spain, Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Turkey, Bulgaria, Poland, Portugal and Russia.

Types of employment opportunities will vary, below are listed some of the employment opportunities that will be available:

Teaching positions based in London will be teaching adults. Accommodation will not be included in your contract. These short contracts range, on average, from 3-6 weeks. Average weekly salary: **AUD\$500 - AUD\$700.**

Summer English courses held around the United Kingdom will be teaching children and teenagers. These short contracts range, on average, from 3-6 weeks. In addition to your salary, accommodation and meals are often provided also. Average weekly salary: **AUD\$480 - AUD\$700.**

Varied teaching opportunities available teaching adults and children. Positions are available in Italy, France, Spain, Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Turkey, Bulgaria, Poland, Portugal and Russia. These short contracts range, on average, from 3-6 weeks. Average weekly salary: **AUD\$420 - AUD\$ 575.** Average weekly salary for Spanish contracts: **AUD\$430 - AUD\$640.**

Visa Requirements

Opportunities for employment will depend on your ability to obtain an appropriate visa, your education level, completion of the Certificate III in TESOL or the Certificate IV in TESOL course and a successful interview process.

To be eligible to work, you will need to obtain one of the following passports or visas:

- European Union Passport
- Ancestry Visa
- Working Holiday Visa
- Spousal Visa
- Any other visa that will make YOU eligible to work in part or all of the European Union

Please note employment opportunities will only be available to people who successfully obtain a relevant visa which will allow you to work legally in one of the following European countries; United Kingdom, Italy, France, Spain, Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Turkey, Bulgaria, Poland, Portugal and Russia.

If you are ineligible for a visa that will allow you to legally work, you are still able to undertake the course with Teach International in London but we will be unable to offer or guarantee you European employment opportunities on completion of the course.

Degree?

A University Bachelor's Degree in any discipline will enhance your employment options. However, it is NOT a necessity for jobs in mainland Europe, excluding the United Kingdom where a University Degree is a requirement. Please see the chart below for a general idea on your immediate employability after completion of the course during the European summer months.
